

Embossing allows a dimensional design to be imprinted. A metal plate containing an image in relief is pressed into the paper using heat and pressure to create a raised (emboss) or lowered (deboss) image.

TIPS

- Heavier cover-weight papers can support greater embossing depth than a thinner paper can.
- Consider making your graphics or typography slightly larger to enhance the effect of embossing.
- When embossing on a finished piece, allow a half-inch margin from the edge of the trim line.
- Because the embossed area is smoothed out, a textured paper will provide a greater contrast in texture.
- Blind embossing looks best on dark, flat backgrounds or with some finishing applied on top.
- Consider the reverse side of the emboss. Hide or embrace the reverse pattern and incorporate it into your design.
- Very fine lines do not emboss well. This is particularly problematic on thicker materials. When you emboss a fine line on a thick or heavy stock the emboss effect tends to be very subtle.
